MODULE 8: CUSTOMISING TEI, ODD, ROMA

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For a TEI project involving a critical edition of Samuel Beckett's *Waiting for Godot*, create a TEI customisation with the Roma application.

1. Starting from a minimal TEI schema, create a customisation called **myGodot**.
2. Include the **drama**, **textcrit**, and **transcr** modules.
3. Remove the [<facsimile>](#), [<surface>](#), and [<zone>](#) elements from the **transcr** module.
4. Save your customisation.
5. Create PDF documentation for your project team.
